Abstract of the exhibition catalogue: Astronomical Seeing, New works by Lyndi Sales, 2010, KHAN+PEARMATH EXHIBITS Group

Within the works currently presented by Lyndi Sales under the title Astronomical Seeing graphical-geometrical forms prevail: hexagons and diamonds, spirals, nets, satellite-like and starshaped figures as well as combs. They were cut out, burned, from various types of paper, printed cartons, papers additionally painted with water color, acrylic or markers, from holographic papers or even from newspapers. These figures, although they were fixed from Sales on two-dimensional surfaces, can rather be attributed to the genre of sculpture than graphics. They appear three-dimensional due to the different heights erected from Sales when attaching these figures on paper-backgrounds with pins. And yet, it is the genre of graphics with which Sales actually links...
